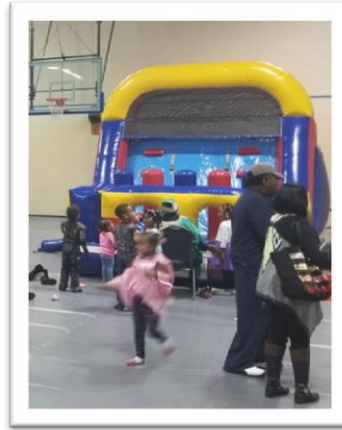
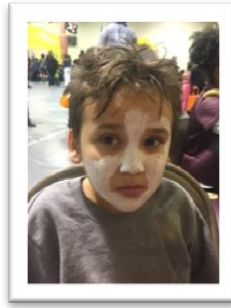
Sister Morrison of High Street Baptist Church was the winner of the Trunk or Treat Contest, decorating her trunk to feature “An Evening in Paris”.
